



The Little Sugar MTB course travels north into Bella Vista and traverses the hollers and ravines of Little Sugar and Back 40. Set on a world-class urban trail system, the event offers grinding climbs that alternate with fasting rolling descents. Athletes are greeted with a backdrop of unique bluff lines, waterfalls, the iconic Ledges and a view of the picturesque Crystal Bridges Museum of American Art.
