TWIN LAKES DAM

To ensure that all crews are able to meet and support their athletes in a timely manner, we will have limited parking and 20+ shuttles available.

How to Get There:

Gold, Silver, and Red Corrals:

- · Limited Parking at Twin Lakes Dam. Athletes will receive:
 - 1 Parking tag Color Coded to Athlete Corral Color
 - 4 Crew member Wristbands Color Coded to Athlete Corral Color
 - Wristbands not required for kids 10 & under

All Other Corrals:

- Crews must park/shuttle from Outward Bound. Athletes will receive:
 - No Parking Pass needed
 - Four **Blue** Crew wristbands

TWIN LAKES DAM SETUP INFORMATION:

Friday, August 9th from 2:00pm-10:00pm

- Staff will be on site to help you get set up, and security will be in place all night.
- Please plan to drop all large items on Friday as they will not be allowed on shuttles on Race Day, including:
 - Tents (10x10 only)
 - Coolers
 - Chairs
 - Strollers that cannot be folded and transported quickly

How to bring your belongings back to Leadville:

- Staff will remain onsite. Crews will have two options:
 - · As time and space allow, crews can take gear back on the shuttles after 12:00pm
 - Beginning at 4:00pm, crews are welcome to drive to Twin Lakes to pick up their belongings.





SHUTTLE DETAILS

First and foremost - WE WILL GET YOU TO YOUR ATHLETES!

- Help us by knowing your athletes' expected arrival at Twin Lakes.
- · Grab a shuttle at a corresponding time.
- · We encourage you to pack efficiently so that all crews have enough space and shuttles can leave in a timely manner!

20+ shuttles will loop from Outward Bound to Twin Lakes Dam throughout the day

- · They will begin at 5:00am on Race Day
- They will loop until all folks are through on the inbound from Columbine.
- CUT-OFF has been moved from Pipeline to Outward Bound, and extended to 4:00 pm.

YOU MUST SIGN A WAIVER

- These will be available at the Athlete meeting on Friday the 9th from 10:00am 11:00am.
- They will also be available both Thursday/Friday during Packet Pick Up.
- · Once you sign, we will give you a happy face so you do NOT have to sign every time.
 - Please don't wash the stamps off till the end of Race day.

Crew must abide by Lake County & Chaffee County laws, race rules, listen and respect ALL Leadville Race Series Staff, Volunteers, and personnel in enforcement uniform or vests.

If you fail to abide and respect our community you will be asked to leave and your athlete may be disqualified!

DO

Use the Shuttle System

Setup early on Friday Aug. 9th from 2:00pm - 9:00pm

take all your tents, coolers, chairs and larger items to Twin Lakes Dam on Friday Aug. 9th from 2:00pm - 9:00pm

Plan with your athlete on expected arrival

Catch the shuttle at a time coordinating with your athletes expected time

Be nice humans to all our staff and volunteers - they are real people - that work real hard

Follow all directives of our staff

Bring your happy/patient human self so that everyone has a good experience!

Please **DON'T**

DRIVE to Twin Lakes if your athlete is NOT in Gold, Red. Silver Corrals.

WE WILL TURN YOU AROUND

Drive to Twin Lakes WITHOUT your Gold / Silver/ Red Parking Pass.

Bring any items that WON'T fit on your lap on Race Day
